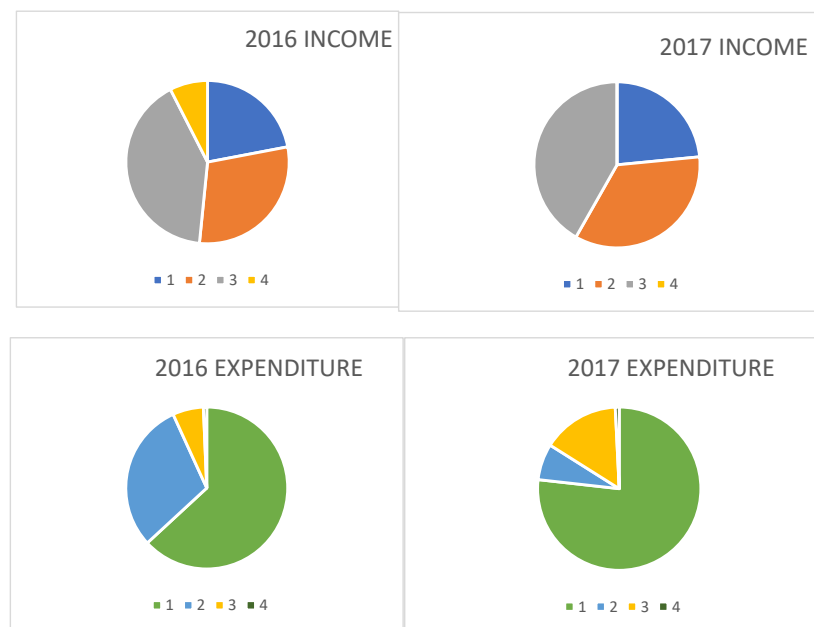

Over the period February 2017 - March 2018, visits to our project partners and to our mission associates have taken us to Kenya, Tanzania, South Africa., Zambia, Israel-Palestine and Nepal.
